


Login

To login to the GCSAA Conference App you will use the **email address used to register and your first name**. First name is case sensitive for example Becky = correct, becky = incorrect.

Login = Email address









Agenda

If you have registered for a seminar, that information will appear in "My Agenda".









My Profile

Edits can be made to My Profile including adding a photo. Once an edit has been made updates from our database will stop and you will be in control of the information.









Chat

This is an in app messaging option.


To start "Chat", select the pencil/paper icon. Registrants you have already connected with will be listed. Select the search icon to find a new registrant.





Video call and picture sharing in Chat

To start a video call, click on the video icon bottom left. To share a photo, click on the camera icon in the bottom right.








Group Chat

For group chat select the "Add Group" chat icon.

Registrants you have already connected with will appear. The search icon will allow you to find new registrant.

Select at least one registrant to start group chat. Add a name for group and then select "Save".



Once the group has been saved, select the plus icon to add other registrants and search for names.






Notes

Select the plus icon to add a note. Once you are finished with your note, you will be prompted to enter an email address.










Camera Permission to Scan Barcodes
